Dandridge has a new garbage collection system which will be cleaner, more economical, and easier for you. We will need your help as we work out the best way to operate the System. Please study the information enclosed so that the transition will be as smooth and effortless as possible for all of us.

With the new system, each household is being provided a new garbage container. Each Container has a serial number and is assigned to a specific address. The container is to remain at that address. If additional cans are needed, they may be purchased at a cost of **\$65.00** per container. A form is enclosed for purchasing, additional containers.

The container that we have left for you, has been placed in the location best suited for pickup by our new garbage truck. The truck has an automated arm which reaches out to pick up the container, empties it, and returns it to its specified location.


\*\*\*Please note that the container must be at least five feet from any tree, shrub, mailbox, light pole, etc.

No other garbage cans can be used with our new truck. Garbage must be inside the 96 gallon container provided by the Town.

After the cans have been emptied, they may be brought back from the road. (Don't forget to have them back out by 7am for pick up the following week.)

We know that you will work with us to take care of our new equipment and to make Dandridge the cleanest, prettiest, town in the country!

## THE FOLLOWING ARE RULES IN REGARD TO USE OF THE NEW CONTAINER SYSTEM:

- If you have more than one Town cans the cans must be at least five feet apart.
- Please place garbage cans at roadside by 7:00 AM the day your service.
- Do not place cans within 5 ft. of trees, shrubs mailboxes, light poles, etc.
- Set cans with short bar towards roadside.
- Do not place sharp objects such as scrap steel in cans.
- Do not place brush or grass clippings in can. These items are picked up with brush on Friday.
- Do not place hot ashes or cinders in cans.
- Do not place, rocks, brick, or block in cans.
- Do not place garbage on top of, or outside the containers. Do not use any other containers than the Town containers. This garbage will not be picked up.
- Do not put used oil in or beside containers. Used oil will be picked on recycle
- Light weight paper placed on top of the garbage in the container may blow out onto your driveway or yard as the garbage is being dumped into the truck. Please try to put heavier garbage in the top so this will not happen.
- Do not place building material in garbage

**WARNING: IF YOU PLACE OBJECTS IN THE CONTAINERS THAT DAMAGE THE CONTAINER OR GARBAGE TRUCK, YOU WILL RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THESE OBJECTS.**

# Your guide to our Neighborhood Recycling Program

Please have recyclable by roadside by 7:00 AM.

Recycle items can be put in plastic trash bag(s), or in a trash container the resident provides.

Recycle items do not have to be separated.

Thursday recycle pickup will be for residents who have their trash pickup on Mon. or Tues.


Friday is recycle pickup day for the Epcoc Dr area.



## Used Oil Recycling

We accept used motor oil from vehicle and lawn mowers. Place oil in a clean, plastic jug with a lid, and mark on the jug "used oil". Place by the curbside with your other recyclables.

Acceptable oil products include motor oil, transmission fluid, brake fluid, power steering fluid, and household vegetable oils. **DO NOT INCLUDE GASOLINE.** Oils will be tested for gasoline and if contaminated, will be left by the curbside for residents' disposal.



## Newspaper

Includes magazines and phone books. Place on top of other recyclables to serve as a lid for your bin. **DO NOT INCLUDE hard back books, wax paper, or Christmas paper.**



## Glass Bottles and Jars

Include green, brown, and clear glass. Rinse all food and beverage glass containers. Remove lids and rings. Paper labels do not need to be removed.

**DO NOT INCLUDE light bulbs, chemical containers, window glass, mirrors, or ceramics.**



## Steel Food and Beverage Cans

Please rinse. Paper labels do not need to be removed. **DO NOT include paint cans, aerosol cans, or automotive product cans.**



## Aluminum Food and Beverage Cans

Crushed cans help free up space in our recycle trucks.



## PETE Plastic Containers

(Look for label on bottom of container.) Rinse containers. Squeeze containers to conserve space in the recycle trucks. **Be sure to take off lids and place them in household trash.**



## HDPE Plastic Pourable Household Containers

(Look for label on bottom of container.), Rinse containers. Squeeze containers to conserve space in our trucks. **DO NOT INCLUDE automotive or chemical product containers. Be sure to take off lids and place them in household trash.**

## Cardboard

Moving/storage/store boxes, including cereal boxes, are acceptable. **Cardboard must be broken down or it will not be picked up.**

**Please note: We do not take any styrofoam products. Please, no food scraps.**

## **CURBSIDE PICKUP**

### **GARBAGE PICKUP**

**MONDAY ROUTE** - all residents east of First Methodist Church including Hopewell St., Milldale, Elmer Lane, E. Price, W. Price, E. Dumplin Valley, W. Dumplin Valley, and Cline Rd.

**TUESDAY ROUTE** - all residents west of First Methodist Church including Patriot Drive, Goose Creek Rd., Hart Rd., Jerimac Lane, Charles Court, Daniel Dr., Delores Dr., and Killion Rd.

**WEDNESDAY ROUTE** - All residents on Epco Dr.

NOTE - Have garbage by roadside by 7:00 AM the day of service. If a holiday falls on Monday, Monday's route will be run on Tuesday and Tuesday's route will be run Wednesday. Wednesday's trash route will be run on Thursday.

### **CLASS 4**

**WEDNESDAY** - Consists of appliances, furniture, carpet, metal, televisions, etc. Usually run every other Wednesday.

### **RECYCLING**

The week of Thanksgiving, there will be no recycle pickup.

### **BRUSH**

**FRIDAY** - Leaves and brush must be by roadside. Usually run on Friday. Small cuttings or trimmings, and grass cuttings must be bagged. Brush needs to be laid along side of road (parallel to roadway).

Brush or cuttings not piled as described will be left. With your cooperation, & usual equipment can be used and time saved. **If brush is cut by a contractor, it must be disposed of by a contractor.**

**We do not pick up tree stumps, rocks, gravel, or dirt.**

### **LEAF PICKUP-USUALLY BEGINNING THE LAST WEEK OF OCTOBER**

Leaves should be raked to the curb for pickup and mulching. We ask your cooperation by raking or blowing leaves to curb in wind rows and piles. Leaves must be free of sticks, branches, and rocks that may damage leaf vacuum. If damage is caused to the equipment by such objects in your leaves, you will be responsible for the damages. If debris and sticks are excessive, leaves will be left for residents' disposal. Weather permitting, leaves will be picked up Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. We hope to service each street twice a week during leaf season. Your cooperation helps us move faster.

### **LEAF MULCH AND CHIPS**

At the new public works building at 267 W. Hwy. Hwy 25/70, we have mulch and chips available for you to load at no cost for use in gardening and landscaping. This can be picked up between 7:00 AM and 3:30 PM Monday through Friday.
