The motion failed for lack of a second.

It came on a motion by Alderman JONES, seconded by Vice-Mayor NELSON, to suspend the beer permit for 30 days, beginning on 1/14/15, due to the fact that this was the second violation within 12 months.


VIII. ADJOURNMENT
